

Topeka USBC Bowling Association Bowler of the Year Point System

1. To be considered for the bowler of the year award, members must or exceed the following requirements:
 - A. Must be a member in good standing of the Topeka USBC Bowling Assn.
 - B. Bowl in a minimum of one league in each of at least two different bowling centers in the city of Topeka.
 - C. Bowl a minimum of 2/3 of the leagues scheduled games (i.e. 68 of 102).
2. Composite Average: All games bowled in certified Topeka USBC BA leagues, excluding Travel leagues, will be counted in computing the composite average. Note: Final average sheets not received by the Topeka USBC BA association manager by May 5 may not be accepted. Points for the ten highest averages will be assigned as follows:

1 st = 50 points;	2 nd = 45 points;	3 rd = 40 points;	4 th = 35 points;
5 th = 30 points;	6 th = 25 points;	7 th = 20 points;	8 th = 15 points;
9 th = 10 points;	10 th = 5 points.		
3. League Credits: League credits will be earned by bowling at least 2/3 of a leagues scheduled games for each certified league, excluding travel leagues, using the table below.

4. Honor Scores: Nationally recognized honor score will be awarded points as assigned as follows:

Series:	Game:
900 = 50 points	300 = 10 points
826 – 899 = 30 points	299 = 08 points
800 – 825 = 15 points	298 = 05 points
11 in a row = 04 points	
5. City Tournament(s) All Event scores: Participants who have entered any one of three all events categories in the City tournament and all events in the Mixed tournament will receive the following points for high scratch scores. 1st = 10 points; 2nd = 8 points; 3rd = 6 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 2 points.
6. Bonus Points: Bowlers will be awarded points for their current participation in areas of bowling in Topeka as follows:
 - A. Certified or Registered instructor = 5 points.
 - B. President or Secretary of a certified league = 5 points.
 - C. Topeka USBC BA officer or director = 5 points.
 - D. Bowl in two or more events in the City tournament = 5 points.
 - E. Topeka USBC BA Association Manager = 100 points.
7. After all the above criteria has been met, The Topeka USBC BA board of directors will have the final vote to determine who will be awarded the Topeka Bowler of the Year!!!
